LOCATION & MASTER PLAN

As the main subway arrival and departure point for beachgoers and resident commuters, the retail transit plaza is the keystone to the Arverne-By-The-Sea masterplan. With its long curved plaza reaching east and west along the new Rockaway Beach Boulevard and the memory of the de-mapped 68th street piercing the site north and south, the retail transit plaza offers pedestrian links to communities new and old. Neighborhood retail provides necessities to the area and creates a town square that acts as the central hub for area residents commuting to the city or for those visiting this revitalized beachfront community.







CREATING A NEW STATION FROM OLD

CASTING A FACADE


