### studio culture





Perkins Eastman is an international practice with studios located around the world. Each studio has its own personality and expression steeped in the city within which it is located and the people who comprise it. Fostering this spirit of creative expression is at the heart of our studio culture and commitment to diversity and inclusion.

Our studios are places to build transformative personal and professional relationships. We cultivate opportunities to learn from and grow with one another; that growth mindset is codified in our firmwide mentorship program. Mentor pairings are encouraged across studios, practice areas, and fields of expertise to inspire knowledge sharing.

Bridging across the individual studios are the systems that provide consistency within the studio culture and aim to provide an equitable work experience for all. Among these systems are our Guiding Principles, a set of ten statements that encapsulates our philosophy. One of the central ideas is this: Design is our passion and our purpose. **End Greenwashing.** We're making commitments to our clients, collaborators, colleagues, and communities. We will no longer tolerate "greenwashing"—the practice of providing misinformation around environmental value—in any form, neither in our industry nor in the product and manufacturing industry, whether it's intentional or not.

**Reduce Annual Predicted Energy Use Intensity.** As signatories of the AIA 2030 Commitment, in which we've pledged to design toward carbon neutral by the year 2030, we are currently reaching a 48% average predicted energy use intensity (pEUI) reduction across the firm, and improving each year.

**Reach for High-Performance Design.** Many of our projects completed in the past year have reached ambitious sustainability goals, including Net Zero Energy, LEED Platinum, WELL, and Fitwel certifications, as well as Passive House designations.
